



Hathaway Academy Summer School 2021 – Summary Statement

Name:	Hathaway Academy
Overview:	The Hathaway Academy Summer School 2021 was delivered on site by academy staff for the first week of the school summer holidays as was aimed at Year 6 (soon to be Year 7) students joining the academy in September 2021. The focus of the summer school was to provide a broad and balanced range of activities that would support student' transition into the academy, help close academic gaps, boost mental and physical well-being and celebrate individual student achievements.
Summer School Dates:	Monday 26 th July 8.30am-3.30pm, Tuesday 27 th July 8.30am-3.30pm, Wednesday 28 th July 8.30am-3.30pm. Thursday 8.30am-3.30pm, Friday 8.30am-3.30pm.
Places Offered:	90 Year 7 (September 2021) invited, 20 eligible for pupil premium, 70 not eligible for pupil premium.
Places Delivered:	46 Year 7 (September 2021) delivered, 15 eligible for pupil premium, 31 not eligible for pupil premium.
Places Attended:	Day 1 = 46 attended, Day 2 = 46 attended, Day 3 = 46 attended, Day 4 = 46 attended, Day 5 = 46 attended.
Activities Provided:	Throughout the duration of the summer school week a variety of activities were delivered by Hathaway Academy Staff. These included transitional activities such as meeting teachers, staff, school tours, team building and problem solving; additional subject support activities such as English, Maths and Science targeted lessons; Arts based activities such as model making, craft creating and drawing development and Sports based activities combining individual and team games such as basketball, badminton, table tennis, dodgeball and inter faculty competitions. In addition to these activities each day finished with a celebration assembly in the academy hall to reward the 10 daily "Hathaway Stars" who were rewarded with a certificate for demonstrating excellent effort, character or attainment through the duration of the day.
