Curriculum Subject	Summer 1 & 2 Curriculum Focus Area – Year 10
English	English Literature Focus – Anthology Poetry and Inspector Calls Key Text by J.B. Priestly, development of exam techniques and analysis of writer’s technique.
Mathematics	Multiplicative Reasoning and Justification, Similarity and Congruence, 2 D and 3 D Shape – Perimeter, Area, Volume calculations and problem solving.
Science	Homeostasis and Response (Biology), Rate and Extent of Chemical Change (Chemistry), Forces (Physics).
Geography	Understanding the “Physical” Geography of Coasts including local and national examples, developing knowledge of “Fieldwork” including required visits for Paper 3 preparation.
History	Exploring causes and impact of World War 1 with ongoing development of source work, developing knowledge of “America 1920” as exam theme.
Religious Studies	Paper 1 Focus on “Crime and Punishment” with development of exam technique; Paper 2 Focus on “Christian Beliefs” and “Islamic Beliefs”.
Spanish / French	Developing speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in French and Spanish with a focus on the topic of “Health”, applying different tenses.
Physical Education (GCSE)	Practical Component focus on Individual Sport – Badminton, Trampolining, Athletics, Theoretical Component focus – Prevention and Treatment of Injury.
Art	Building and developing Portfolio 1 for N.E.A. with the focus on “Natural Form” including researching, replicating and stencilling.
Drama	Building and developing Component 2 “Devising Coursework” with a focus on improvisation, performance skills and responding to a stimulus.
Digital Information Technology	Component 3 Exam Focus, understanding and applying knowledge of Cloud Storage Systems, I.T. Platforms and Services and Security Applications.
Hospitality & Catering	Theoretical Focus – Nutritional Importance and the key factors of a balanced diet. Practical Focus – Developing NEA Skills through the dishes of Chicken Chow Mein, Meatballs and Tomato Sauce, Apple Tart, Pork Stroganoff.
Photography	Building and developing Portfolio 1 for N.E.A. with the focus on “Landscape Photography” including researching targeted artist work and stimulus.
Business Studies	Theme 1.4 – Paper 1 “Opportunity for Small Business Start Up” including Location, Business Ownership, The Marketing Mix and Business Plans.
Business Management	Investigating Business Growth, including “Internal Growth” and “External Growth” and the challenges faced when looking to expand.

Statistics	Unit 4 – Exam Content “Scatter Graphs” and “Time Series Graphs” including how to analyse and interpret varying data sets.
