



Curriculum Subject	Summer 1 & 2 Curriculum Focus Area – Year 7
English	Non-Fiction Writing, including analysis, annotation and structuring of speeches, letters and popular written articles.
Mathematics	Fractions, Order of Operations, Percentages, 2-Dimensional (2D) Shape, Addition and Subtraction of Fractions.
Science	Ecosystems and Adaptations, Elements, Atoms, Mixtures and The Processes of Separating Techniques.
Geography	Major United Kingdom Physical Landscapes, Weather Systems and The Comparative Climate of the United Kingdom.
History	Important Influential Rulers of England over time, The Tudors and key historically linked events.
Religious Studies	Fundamental ideas, beliefs and traditions linked to two of the major religions of Christianity and Islam.
Spanish	Developing confidence and ability to speak, listen, read and write in Spanish on the topics of Sports and Hobbies and Musical Interests in different tenses.
Physical Education	Acquiring and developing the desired performance and selecting and applying the required skills in the activities of Basketball, Fitness and Athletics.
Art	Exploring Patterns, understanding symmetry and developing the skill / technique of Mark Making through the topic of Insects.
Drama	Using a range of sources and materials to focus on the key dramatic skill of devising from a stimulus, with a focus on performance confidence.
ICT	Programming, including an introduction to a range of software to learn basic and more advanced skills of ordering operations.
Food Technology	Developing practical skills for use in food and kitchen preparation through the making of Apple Crumble, Pasta Bake, Mini Carrot Cakes, Sauage Rolls.
Photography	Accessing and using Photoshop to develop creative skills when designing a festival on screen including merchandise, displays and launch details.
Reading	Developing literacy, interpretation and inference skills through reading the chosen text of either “The Boy in the Stiped Pyjamas by John Boyne” or “The Creakers by Tom Fletcher”.
