



Curriculum Subject	Summer 1 & 2 Curriculum Focus Area – Year 9
English	Key Text “Dt Jekyll and Mr Hyde” by Robert Louis Stevenson, including a focus on Gothic Horror and understanding writers’ perspective and techniques used for character development.
Mathematics	Understand and Interpreting Graphs, Solving Equations and Inequalities, Angles and Angle Rules in Shape.
Science	Disease, Infection and Response, Chemical Changes and Reactions, Energy Changes and Reactions.
Geography	Key Concepts of Energy Sources and Energy Usage, Factors contributing to and affecting Climate Change.
History	Understand the historical context, key events and causes of the Holocaust, Second World War and The Cold War.
Religious Studies	Exploring holistic and world views of “Peace” and “Conflict”, developing an understanding and application of morals and ethics.
Spanish / French	Developing confidence and ability to speak, listen, read and write in Spanish / French on the topic of Holidays, people and relationships and reading preferences in past and present tenses.
Physical Education	Acquiring and developing the desired performance and selecting and applying the required skills in the activities of Basketball, Fitness and Athletics.
Art	Pop Art and Illusion, investigating the artistic movement, key features and replicating the required techniques, including an opportunity for simplifying objects.
Drama	Physical Theatre, exploring stage techniques and themes in order to further enhance performance skills and confidence.
ICT	Digital Working Practices, investigative studies looking at the use of Cloud Storage and Cyber Security.
Food Technology	Embedding practical skills for use in food preparation through the making of Bolognese Sauce, Cheesecake, Stuffed Peppers, Double Chocolate Muffins.
Photography	Extending and Mastering Photoshop to develop creative skills when designing and editing formal and informal images.
Reading	Developing literacy, interpretation and inference skills through reading the chosen text of either “The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne” or “Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief by Rick Riordon”.
